As part of the meeting, we decided to begin exploring withdrawal from the United Methodist Church more fully. As a reminder, there are two means of withdrawal. One is the closing of the church, and the other is what is called disaffiliation. Both are simply a means of working with the Mississippi Annual Conference to gain release from the Trust Clause. (All our building and grounds and all our bank accounts are owned in trust of the United Methodist Church.)

In the next month or so, we will have an informational meeting with our district superintendent, Dr. Stephen Cook, and with our conference treasurer, David Stotts. That meeting will likely be in October.

In the meantime, we will try to provide you with more information through the church, and I will be doing some short videos on our church YouTube channel. So, please keep an eye out for them. If you'd like me to meet with you personally or with a group of you, please let me know. I am glad to help any way I can.


