Please meet in the Fellowship Hall at 10:45.





Vote to Join the Global Methodist Church



Last Sunday, March 26, we had a Congregational Meeting following our morning worship service. After a brief time of discussion, a motion was made for our congregation to join the Global Methodist Church. The vote was held by paper ballot.

The motion passed 97 'yes' to 2 'no.' So, it was a 98% majority.

As a reminder, we are still a United Methodist congregation until our disaffiliation is finalized at the end of June. First, the Annual Conference will meet Wednesday, June 28, in Tupelo to vote to approve disaffiliating churches. Second, our trustees will work with Conference officials to finalize the disaffiliation agreement and receive our release from the Trust Clause. Our first day to officially be a Global Methodist congregation would be July 1, 2023.
