Special Announcement to our Congregation

This past Sunday, April 6, it was announced in worship that Bishop Scott Jones has appointed me to be the next Conference Superintendent for the Mississippi-West Tennessee Conference. Bishop Jones has asked that I begin working as the part-time Conference Superintendent starting June 1, while continuing to serve as your pastor full-time here at First Methodist Church in Yazoo City.

There is a proposal to Annual Conference this May to expand the Conference Superintendent to a full-time position. If that is approved, then Bishop Jones anticipates that I should move into that full-time role as early as July 1. However, he has given us some flexibility on that transition date. So, that transition could be as late as August 1, if needed. The goal is to provide a smooth transition here in Yazoo City.

Bill Kyle is the chair of our Staff-Parish Relations Committee (SPRC). And he has already begun along with our other Staff-Parish members to work toward our next pastoral appointment. Remember that one of the differences between the Global Methodist Church and the UMC is that the local church has significantly more say on who is appointed as their pastor.

So, the Presiding Elder and Cabinet will work to provide at least three excellent pastoral candidates to meet with the Staff-Parish. Staff-Parish will make their recommendation to the Cabinet as to which candidate they would prefer. Where the Staff-Parish, the pastoral candidate, and the Cabinet all agree, that is what will be recommended to Bishop Jones for a formal pastoral appointment.

Once that appointment is announced, we will work toward a transition to allow the new pastor to end well at his or her current appointment and begin the work to move here to Yazoo City.

During this appointment process, Staff-Parish will be the primary point of contact with the Presiding Elder and Cabinet. Understandably, to do their work well they will have to maintain strict confidentiality. This means that they will not be able to discuss who the candidates are or any details about them since that would complicate things for the pastoral candidates.

However, we do encourage you to talk with each Staff-Parish member and to share your hopes and dreams for our church, the things you value most in a pastor, and the needs you believe are most pressing for us here in Yazoo City. This will help them represent you well in this process. Our goal is to help provide a pastor who will be here ideally for the next ten years and will help our church thrive during that time.

In the meantime, I ask that you keep all of us in your prayers. Pray for our church. Pray for its leaders. Pray particularly for Bill Kyle and each of the members of Staff-Parish. And I would ask, please also pray for me and our Annual Conference as we move into this new season.
