Update from Staff-Parish Relations Committee

This past Sunday Bill Kyle, the chair of the Staff-Parish Relations Committee, gave a brief update on our pastoral transition.

The SPRC met on Thursday, May 15, with Dr. Barry Male, the interim Conference Superintendent and Presiding Elder over the Madison district. He is also the Senior Pastor at Madison Methodist Church. Dr. Male will be working with Staff-Parish throughout the appointment process.

Dr. Male reminded us that the Global Methodist Church uses a modified appointment system. The Cabinet, which is the Conference Superintendent and all Presiding Elders, will work together to provide 3 or 4 qualified candidates for Staff-Parish to interview.

Staff-Parish will then meet with each candidate to interview them. Dr. Male reminded the committee that confidentiality is of utmost importance since some of the pastoral candidates may be active pastors at another church. As a result, there will not be any trial sermons. However, the Staff-Parish will be able to view online sermons from each candidate.

Bill shared that he expects interviews to begin after the first of June. After the interviews, the Staff-Parish will make its recommendation to Dr. Male and the Cabinet. If Staff-Parish, the pastoral candidate, and the Cabinet are all in agreement, that becomes the appointment, and our Conference Superintendent will send a formal request asking Bishop Scott Jones to "fix" the appointment.

Once the appointment has been finalized, Staff-Parish will work with the Cabinet to set an official start date for the new pastor and work toward a good transition.
