On Pentecost, we remember when the Holy Spirit descended on Jesus' disciples. As they gathered in Jerusalem 10 days after Jesus' ascension, they saw tongues of fire, heard rushing wind and began speaking in many languages. Because the

disciples could then share the good news with all the pilgrims assembled for the Pentecost festival, the occasion marks the birthday of the Christian church. That day alone, about 3,000 people devoted their lives to Christ.

Like the Holy Spirit, Pentecost is important and relevant today. As theologian Henri Nouwen writes, "Without Pentecost the Christ-event — the life, death and resurrection of Jesus — remains imprisoned in history as something to remember, think about and reflect on. The Spirit of Jesus comes to dwell within us, so that we can become living Christs here and now."



Mississippi-West Tennessee Annual Conference



Annual Conference met this past Thursday through Saturday (May 29-31) at Christ Church in Memphis, TN. Over 580 laity and pastors gathered from all over Mississippi and Tennessee. We currently have around 220 churches throughout the conference.

In many ways it was more like a Homecoming service than a conference meeting: very little business, a whole lot of worship. We heard powerful sermons, joined in uplifting worship, and received challenging teaching.

Bishop Scott Jones presided, reminding us of our calling to make disciples of Jesus Christ and to spread scriptural holiness across the globe. At the Friday ordination service he ordained 11 more pastors: 3 deacons and 8 elders.

Our guest preacher was **Dr. Luther Oconer**, the conference superintendent for the **Mega Manilla Conference** in the Philippines. Then, as part of our business session, we entered into a formal Mission Partnership with both the Mega Manilla Conference and the **Covenant Conference** of the Philippines. Every year part of our connectional funding will go to help support ministry of churches in the Philippines, including a Philippine church plant in the Muslim middle eastern country of Qatar.

Finally, the delegates did vote to affirm the appointment of Rev. Lauren Porter as our new Conference Superintendent, beginning part-time on June 1 and then becoming full-time by August 1.
