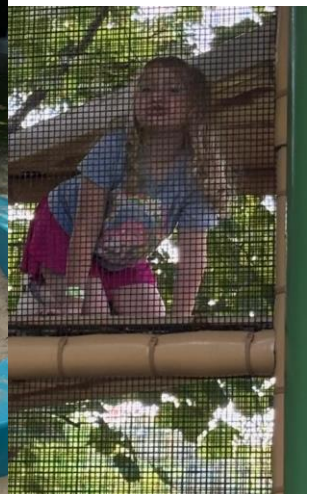
Guest Speaker

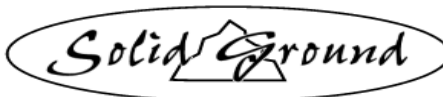


The Edge: 4th-6th Grade
