It is good for us to find opportunities to celebrate one another in the local church. Birthdays and anniversaries are good. Even better? Baptisms. Baptism, among other things, is a sign of biblical obedience to Christ. Specifically, when the resurrected Christ appeared to the disciples, he issued the Great Commission: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matt. 28:18-20). To have received baptism is to have been a part of this biblical imperative.

There are a number of things every local church is expected to record with respect to everyone on the membership roll, stipulated in ¶429 of the Book of Doctrines & Discipline. Among those is the date of one's baptism, along with the location, the name of the one who baptized you, and what local church body they represented. Over the coming months/years I will be working to update our church's means of recording the discipleship journeys of our people. I wanted to ask that you do what you can to track down what records you have about your baptism so that I can do my part, not only to record good membership records, but to actually minister to you where you are. A big part of knowing you now is knowing where your journey began. Baptism is the entry point to the church, as I have said a few times while preaching on covenant. To celebrate our baptism in Christ is to celebrate his redeeming work among us. Thank you for your attentive care in this matter.
