

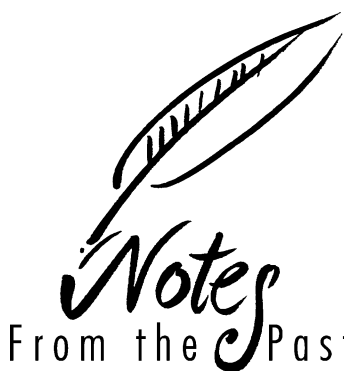

Audits and inventories aren't any fun. I used to work in retail, and I hated when it was time for inventory. So boring. And as a pastor, I have had to oversee annual financial audits. Also, not fun. I know I'm not alone in this feeling. Very few enjoy the punctilliar detail-oriented requirements of these procedures. And the folks who DO enjoy these things are often not very fun to be around! Vicious cycle. But the thing is: We need to know what we are working with. Humans are delusional creatures. When the Dunning-Kruger Effect is a real thing (look it up), and confirmation bias is rife, we have to have a sober, objective view of things. The only way to do that is to take the time to list things out. That's what I'm doing right now with our church membership. It is going to take months.

I wanted to invite you to take an inventory on your life. Look at how you spend your time, your attention, your energy, your money. These things speak to what your true values are. Lent is coming up in a few weeks, a season of intentional self-denial and fasting. It'll be an opportunity to reorient yourself. This can only be done rightly after a sober self-inventory. Pray about it!

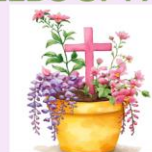
